DIRECTIONS TO HOTEL:	From Airport to Hotel: Head south on Keith Road toward US-90 West. Turn left onto US-90 East/College Street. Then, turn right onto Lindbergh Drive and then a left onto Washington Blvd. Turn right onto Corporate Drive- continue onto Executive Blvd and your destination will be on the right. Approximately 6 miles.
DIRECTIONS TO TRAINING SITE:	From Hotel to BEST Complex: Take I-10 East (towards Orange/Baton Rouge). Take the Magnolia Street Exit and turn Left onto Magnolia. Go under the I-10 and turn Right onto Elm Street. From Elm, turn Right onto Pine Street – then take an immediate Left onto Marina Drive which leads to the Training Complex.
