OSHA requires employers to ensure the capabilities of their rescue service in terms of training, equipment and performance. Roco's CSRT stand-by rescue services can simplify this task by providing trained and equipped responders to assist in meeting your confined space rescue and compliance goals.

For more than 26 years, Roco has been the leader in confined space and rope rescue training and services. Our CSRT team members are experienced in industrial environments and meet all OSHA requirements for entrant, attendant and entry supervisor. Personnel are certified in First Aid/CPR and have been trained in hazard recognition, communications, breathing equipment, personal protective equipment and self-rescue.

A typical Roco CSRT team consists of three personnel, one crew chief and two team members. All team members are certified Confined Space and Rope Rescue Technicians based on the guidelines of NFPA 1006 Professional Qualifications Standard. Depending on the scope of work, Roco may assign a crew chief who is a Certified Occupational Safety Specialist (COSS).

Rescue Technician certification includes both written and performance-based testing, which document skills proficiency as required by OSHA's 1910.46 Permit-Required Confined Space Regulation. Roco team members are required to have emergency response experience, 100 hours in formal rescue training and successfully complete certification prior to their first assignment.

Roco's CSRT policy requires personnel to maintain current Confined Space and Rope Rescue Technician certification status. In order to maintain certification, personnel must complete a minimum of 100 hours per calendar year in CSRT/ Instructor service (or documented training hours) and successfully complete the written certification exam every three years. If this minimum is not met, personnel must complete a recertification process (written exam and practical skills testing) prior to accepting further assignments.

Roco CSRT team members are dedicated to providing safe, effective and dependable confined space rescue services to our clients. In fact, our long-term commitment to safety and quality have been recognized with OSHA's VPP Star award for on-site safety services in New Mexico.
